Child Safeguarding.

The Dublin Diocesan Safeguarding
and Protection service promotes the

Providing training for priests, parish
workers and volunteers in
safeguarding and child protection.
Over the next couple of months an
information morning and evening will
take place in the Parish Centre to bring
all of us up to date with policy, norms
and procedures. These information
days will be run by the Diocesan
Safeguarding Office. The meeting will
explain and bring us up to date with
the norms, guidelines and policy of the
Archdiocese of Dublin which includes
the Garda Vetting of all Parish
workers and volunteers. There will
also be an opportunity for questions
and answers, or indeed any points of
clarification people may have. Further
details will appear in forthcoming
parish newsletters.

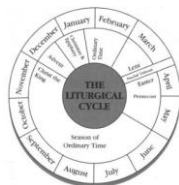
