Ordinary Time is green. We will continue in Ordinary time until the 34th Week in Ordinary Time at the end of November when we begin a new Liturgical year with Advent. During this time each Sunday we will read from St Mark's Gospel in a semi-continuous way. eg Starting today Chapter 4 of Mark, verse 26
