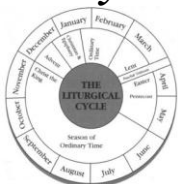


The Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



After 40 days of Lent and 50 days of Easter and the special Celebrations of Pentecost, Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi we return to Ordinary Time today with the 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time. The colour for Ordinary Time is green. We will continue in Ordinary time until the 34th Week in Ordinary Time at the end of November when we begin a new Liturgical year with Advent. During this time each Sunday we will read from St Luke's Gospel in a semi-continuous way. eg Starting with Chapter 7 of Luke, verse 11 this Sunday you can see below how we will read through Luke over the next few weeks:

10 th Sunday	Luke 7:11-17
11 th Sunday	Luke 7:36-8:3
12 th Sunday	Luke 9:18-24
13 th Sunday	Luke 9:51-62
14 th Sunday	Luke 10:1-2, 17-20
15 th Sunday	Luke 10:25-37



This continues in this semi continuous way up to Luke chapter 21. Why not take out your bible and read through these chapters in one sitting. It will make the Sunday listening more meaningful.
