World Meeting of Families August 21st-26th 2018 Dublin

Pope Francis has chosen this meeting to be held in Dublin in August of next year. There is two display boards which give updated information about this gathering and preparations in the city and Parishes over the month's ahead. Parishes around the country have expressed interest in knowing a bit more about what this gathering and the preparations that will begin in Parishes from September. For that reason the organising committee are holding information evenings across the country for representatives of parishes who are interested now in preparing for the World Meeting of Families. These meetings will give a detailed outline of the resources and how they can be availed of.
