For many this pilgrimage is the highlight of the Diocesan calendar year. Each year the Diocese endeavours to bring over 170 sick people to Lourdes. This is a hugely positive experience for them, physically, emotionally and spiritually and provides valuable respite for their families and carers at home. It is also a rewarding experience for all who volunteer. Over 130 secondary school students, along with their teachers help care for the pilgrims. Indeed some students and teachers from De La Salle college here in Churchtown will be represented in this year's pilgrimage.

Parishes throughout the Diocese have shown extraordinary generosity in contributing to the associate membership of the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes in the past.
