With the upcoming referendum on May 25th, The Archbishop of Dublin, Diarmuid Martin has issued a statement on the defence of human life. Copies are available at the back of the Church.

The Archbishop has asked all parishes to have a time of prayer and reflection for the protection of human life this weekend. On this Sunday May 20th there will be exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the main Church from 1 to 5pm with guided prayer, reflections and hymns from 4.30pm to 5pm. All are welcome

A new European Data Protection law, the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”), is being introduced on 25 May 2018.

This new law applies to any organisation, including **our parish** that manages and processes people’s personal information. We are now working on ways of ensuring that what we do with your information is compliant with this new law.
