Both of these events are free but ticketed – every adult and child in attendance will need a ticket to access the venues. **Please note it will not be possible to attend any event or gathering during the World Meeting of families without registering.** This includes the Papal Mass. Places are subject to availability.

The Parish Lotto is over four years old. During that time, we have had three Jackpot winners and more than 450 €25 Lucky Dip winners.

The Parish Lotto is a small but important source of revenue for our parish community. Thanks to it we were able to spend €10,500 last year on the refurbishment of the Kitchen Area and on Seating in our Parish Pastoral Centre

However, revenue has fallen recently to just €130 a week from a high of €280 a week in 2015.

Lotto is fun, and it would be great to have the support of more players - Our Jackpot currently stands at €3,200.
