World Meeting of Families Dublin August 2018 Update

Many thousands of people from all over the world will visit and participate in this unique gathering. The two events for which Pope Francis has confirmed attendance are the Festival of Families on 25th August in Croke Park and the Papal Mass on Sunday 26th August at 3pm in the Phoenix Park.

We have been informed by the World Meeting of Families Office that all events and gatherings are now fully booked including the Papal Mass in the Phoenix Park.

There will be a change to the times of Masses in the Parish on the weekend of the 25th/26th August. For those attending the Papal Mass on August 26th the following information is important and can be found at the world meeting of families website. Facilities will be provided for people with accessibility issues and their carers. Portable seating will be allowed. You do need to be prepared for a lot of walking. **At a minimum, you will be required to walk 4km to and 4km from the Mass and up to 7km to and 7km from, depending on where you are coming from.**

Also with just 5 weeks to go to the World Meeting of Families 2018 in Dublin, we are opening up a new opportunity for those who have availability to volunteer for one day for WMOF2018.
