There will also be a coffee morning in the parish centre this Tuesday 15th August after 10am Mass. It will be an opportunity to say Thank You to Fr. John as he prepares to travel home on Wednesday. Donations from the coffee morning will go towards the continued rebuilding of **St. Mary's School Malongwe**. We wish Fr. John a safe journey and look forward to his presence among us again in the future.
