Blue Board - Liturgical calendar

See the blue board at the Sacred Space
in the church to see how to get the most
out of the Liturgical Calendar.

Copies of these calendars are under the
7th and 8th Stations of the cross at the
entrance, and these are real calendars
which change each year, so you can see
the seasons in the colours - and the feast
days - they are the same as the colours
of our porch lights and the strip light in
the sanctuary.
