

UPDATE ON PASTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

CONCERNING CORONAVIRUS

In order to prevent the spread of the Covid 19 Virus, there will be no further Public Weekday or Weekend Masses in the Church of the Good Shepherd until the 29th March at the earliest. This includes St. Patrick's Day and the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation which was scheduled for March 26th. We have a duty of care to all our parishioners and to all in our country to protect the health of people. The situation will be reviewed regularly as new information becomes available from the healthcare authorities. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Day Mass is now removed. There will be a Mass broadcast from the Church on the webcam on Sundays at 12noon and on St. Patrick's day at 12noon. Weekday Mass will be broadcast each day at 10am (Except Monday). There will be no congregation present for any Mass broadcast on webcam. Masses will also be broadcast on webcam from Ballyroan and Rathfarnham Churches. Please refer to their website for timings.

The Blessed Sacrament Chapel will remain closed until further notice.

The Church will be open during the Day from 11am to 7pm with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 11am - 3pm.

All Pastoral meetings/Pastoral gatherings in the church meeting room and Parish Centre are postponed until further notice.
